ATTENTION PARENTS:

Changes to Child Care Certificates are happening NOW!

As of April 1, 2025, the Mississippi Department of Human Services (DHS) has placed a hold on new and renewing Child Care Payment Program (CCPP) certificates.

What this means:

✓ Families already receiving help may keep their certificate - but ONLY if they fall into one of these six categories:

1. TANF recipient
2. Families recently off TANF
3. Foster Parents
4. Teen Parents
5. Children with disabilities
6. Military or homeless families

⊘ Families NOT IN THESE GROUPS cannot:

- Apply for new certificates
- Renew their current certificates
- Add a child to their account

📣 Let your voice be heard!

- Contact DHS
- Ask them to use federal TANF funds to keep the program open to all families.
- Tell your story. Your voice matters.
