Breaking the cycle of voter apathy must be **intentional**. Children must see us **valuing** our **role** and **voice** in the political process so they can grow up valuing their own role and voice in the political process. Some might ask, "why should we be concerned with introducing the voting concept to children at such an early age?" The answer is simple – children begin to emulate behaviors of significant adults at an early age. Much of what children see, hear and observe they internalize and except as their own, (More Is Caught Than Taught). Exposing children to the voting process on a level they can understand increase our chances of ridding our communities of "voter apathy."
