



# BE PREPARED: MAKE A PLAN TO VOTE ON TUESDAY, NOV. 3

Help those in your family who can't go to the poll in person by calling your County Circuit Clerk to request a mail-in ballot!

**1. Review a sample ballot.** Decide who you will vote for and learn about statewide initiatives on the ballot. Request a sample ballot from your County Circuit Clerk.

**2. Do you know where your voting precinct/poll is located?** If you voted in the last presidential election, it will likely be the same place. You can call your County Circuit Clerk to confirm your voting location.

### **3. Go to the Polls on Tuesday, Nov. 3:**

What time will you get to the polls? Voting polls are open from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Be prepared for possible long lines at the voting poll/precinct. Take water, a snack, and a folding chair if you can't stand for long periods of time. Once you get in line, stay in line and don't be discouraged if the line is long. Once you are in line, the polls must remain open until everyone in line has voted.
